“HIGHWAY TO HEAVEN (PART XV)”

We will continue talking about the different things I have seen and experienced through the years while traveling on this nation’s highways on my way to the next preaching engagement. There have been times when I have traveled without my family, and except for the abiding presence of the Holy Spirit, I have been all alone in the unending vast highways. As I thought about it, I realized that is what many men of God have felt and endured for years as they try to obey the Lord and do His will.

Usually, we travel these roads alone. No family member or Christian friend is really able or willing to listen to the truths that we have to share. And even if they were able and willing to listen to us, I am not sure they would be able to understand. As I travel on the roads, I see the sign that reads “*uneven pavement ahead*” and before I even have time to process the information, I feel the sound of my tires rubbing, bumping and climbing the higher paved road. I think that is how many times I feel as I try to relate things to others in the ministry.

Because people are at different levels in their Christian maturity and spiritual perception, at times it becomes extremely difficult when you try to communicate, most of the times feeling the rubbing and bumping in ***what I will call the uneven pavement syndrome.*** It becomes very difficult to drive in those road conditions. Likewise, it is very difficult to work or have a productive relationship with others who do not agree with us or may be at a different spiritual level than we are. ***(Amos 3:3)***

Revelation usually comes to most ministers very slowly, especially if they have been in ministry for many years. The reason lies mostly in their lack of ability to adjust or change their wineskin (mindset or point of view). ***We are creatures of habits, and old habits are very hard to break.*** After all, what worked for the last twenty years should work today, right? Wrong! As I have stated before, ***we are in the middle of a Christian Reformation that will redefine our concept of what Church is, and its role in the Kingdom of God.*** Many will refuse to climb the higher pavement on the road that is being built by the Lord for His people, and as a result will have to drive on roads that are full of potholes and debris; a road that was once good enough to drive is now being replaced by a new that will allow us to travel faster and smoother.

Right now the Lord is releasing new blueprints for new roads that are being built in the Kingdom of God. The blueprints are being designed by apostles and prophets by divine inspiration and in accordance to God’s Word. This is being done for the benefit of the Church. The Church was ordained by the Lord to be the spiritual scaffold whereby His body is taught, trained, disciplined and then released into their callings and ministries by the presbytery of the local church. Local Churches need to be spiritually connected with godly apostles and prophets that can be part of the presbytery and release the anointings and ministries in the house.
