

e are living in times of much demonic attack. We as the children of the Most High are being called to walk closer to Him and keep our houses in order. No doubt, we are all going to experience some level of demonic attacks as long as we walk on this earth, especially if we are actively engaging the enemy in warfare on a daily basis.

It behooves us then to guard against any open doors that we may have unconsciously opened in our lives and thus invite increasing enemy attacks. Doors are opened by people all the time, and usually they are not aware of what has really happened. This was shown to me some time back in a vision of the night where I saw the accuser of the brethren.

The enemy was accusing the elect and asking the Most High permission to attack them based on things that most of us would consider trivial things, or things that you may think that you do not need to repent for. The things that I heard in the accusations were not big blatant sins that you would expect, but instead little things that we say or do which are sins in God's eyes.

Song of Solomon 2:15 "Catch us the foxes, the little foxes, that spoil the vines: for our vines have tender grapes."

You need to repent and ask our Heavenly Father to forgive you of things that you may have never thought was offensive to Him. You might need to repent of speaking a harsh, offensive word or to someone even though you may think that they deserve it. Something you may have done to someone else in retaliation because you thought they deserved it.

Ask the LORD to reveal to you any open doors that you may have, and then sincerely repent from your heart and ask Him to close them. You need to humble yourself and forgive others who may have offended you in words or deeds. If you don't, a root of bitterness will grow in your heart to the point where it will become a stronghold and defile you.

Hebrews 12:14-15 "Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:

Looking diligently lest any man fall short of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled."

If you have an unforgiving heart it will stop God from helping you in your situation, and if you die in that condition you will end up in torment. Not a good proposition. More believers end up in hell because of this sin than any of the other sins. After you forgive those who offended you and repent, there should be no condemnation in your life. Memories of these things should not bother you.

Once you have shut a demonic door to the enemy, you will then begin a process of recovery where you feel that a weight has been lifted off of you. The only power that the devil has over you is the power you give him through an open doorway into your heart. What you focus on and think about, you will eventually gravitate to. What you fear you empower; fear gives power to what you fear.

Job 3:25 "For the thing which I greatly feared has come upon me, and that which I was afraid of has come unto me."

1 John 4:18 "There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear: because fear has to do with punishment. He that fears is not made perfect in love."

The topic of demonic doorways is vast and comes in many shapes and colors. The entities we call demons are like people without bodies. They prefer to live inside people but many times are attracted to inanimate objects like statues, crafts and paintings. There are certain things that attract them more than others, depending on what the image is.

They are attracted to the night and creatures of the night. There are animals considered creatures of the night that hold a certain attraction to them. Just like a dove symbolizes the Holy Spirit, a frog symbolizes unclean spirits in the Bible. People who practice witchcraft use frogs in their sorcery and witchcraft. Demonic spirits are attracted to images and paintings of frogs.

Revelation 16:13-14 "And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs come out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet. For they are the spirits of demons, working miracles, who go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty."

Another creature of the night that demonic spirits are attracted to are owls. People who have a collection of owls and/or frogs in the form of ceramics, pictures or other form of jewelry or arts of any sort in their home will have open doors to demonic spirits. Any kind of objects that are made in the semblance of creatures of the night are most probably cursed and a magnet for demons.

Isaiah 34:14-15 "The wild beasts of the desert shall also meet with the hyenas, and the wild goat shall cry to his fellow; the night creature also shall rest there, and find for herself a place of rest. There shall the owl make her nest, and lay, and hatch, and gather under her shadow: there shall the kites also be gathered, everyone with her mate."

Also, Native American, Hindu paintings and objects like Buddhas in the form of ceramics, bracelets, amulets, jewelry or other cursed things are points of contact and demonic doorways for evil spirits to have access into the homes of unsuspecting people who think that it's just beautiful, or maybe have grown attached to them because it's a gift from a family or friend.

I recommend that if anyone has these kind of things in your home whether they are in the form of little crafts that you bought on a trip overseas, paintings or a gift from someone else you need to get rid of it. Even pictures that just do not look or feel right in your spirit, you should get rid of it. Anything that smacks of the dark side or feels weird, should not be brought into your home.

Once you get rid of these things by breaking or burning them, you should anoint your house with oil and pray over all the doors and windows of your home; your bedroom, kitchen, living room, yard and any other rooms in your house. When you pray plead the blood of Jesus as you go. If the Holy Spirit shows you anything else, make sure to obey Him and remove it from your house.

2Cor. 6:14-18 "Be you not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship has righteousness with unrighteousness? and what partnership has light with darkness? And what harmony has Christ with Belial? or what part has he that believes with an infidel? And what agreement has the temple of God with idols?

For you are the temple of the living God; as God has said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. Therefore come out from among them, and be you separate, says the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive

you, And will be a Father unto you, and you shall be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty."

We need to make our homes a place where the Holy Spirit feels welcomed. Angels respond differently than demons and are attracted to an atmosphere of worship, prayer and Holiness. If you want to have the presence of the LORD in your home, after you close all demonic doorways that you may have in your homes, saturate your house with prayer, scriptures and worship.

Let your mouth speak words that are in alignment with the word of God. Do not allow contention, foul language or anything corrupt or filthy to enter your home, either physically or through the airwaves. Guard and protect your home and your family as best you are able to. These things mentioned above will help you do that if God be for us, who can be against us.

Psalms 91:9-11 "Because you have made the LORD, who is my refuge, even the most High, your habitation; There shall no evil befall you, neither shall any plague come near your dwelling. For he shall give his angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways."

As I was meditating about this message I was going to send out to you some things began to come into my heart concerning some areas in our lives that we must guard carefully that we do not open demonic doorways. In times past I have shared about the importance to guard our five senses, which are the gates to our soul and spirit.

We have the eye, ear, mouth, nose and touch. All of these are sensory receptors that capture sensory information and transmitted to our soul. Of all the senses, there are two of them that we must use extreme caution as to what we allow to come in through them. The eye is perhaps the most powerful of all the senses as it can capture so much information with just a look.

Matthew 6:22-23 The light of the body is the eye: if therefore your eye be sound, your whole body shall be full of light. But if your eye be evil, your whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in you be darkness, how great is that darkness!

Because of this, it is extremely important that we protect and guard the content of what we allow our eyes to see. If a person looks at something that is corrupt, evil, gory or frightening it can have a lasting effect on their soul that could take days, weeks, months or years to get over. I know people who have seen things so horrific that it marked their lives forever.

Psalms 24:3-4 Who shall ascend into the hill of the LORD? or who shall stand in his holy place? He that has clean hands, and a pure heart; who has not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.

The ear gate is the second most powerful sensory organ that we have. It transmits all kinds of sounds to our brain where our soul resides. Some of these sounds can affect people for good, while others have the opposite effect. Some sounds, words, music have a way of bringing blessing, healing and Shalom to our spirit, soul and body, while others bring pain, fear and torment.

1 John 4:18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear: because fear has to do with punishment. He that fears is not made perfect in love.

If you continually listen to negative reports, news, messages and radio shows that focus on bad things and cause fear and despair, you will open the doorway to spirits of fear, doubt, unbelief and hopelessness into your soul. That is why when we report the news, we try to also share positive, hopeful and faith imparting messages that will edify, comfort and bring hope to the people.

Proverbs 13:12 Hope deferred makes the heart sick: but when the desire is fulfilled, it is a tree of life.

It is important that you set your heart on God's promises, and not on the things of this world. Although we are in the world, we are not of this world. We are pilgrims passing through. We must never forget our identity, who we are in Him. Do not listen to people who are toxic and continually are trying to dump gossip and negative things on you. Be careful what you allow in through your ear gate.

You mouth is another gateway that uses the senses of smell and taste. However, the mouth is different than your eyes and ears in that it is not what comes in at the mouth that can defile you. It is what comes out of your mouth that can defile you and open a doorway for the enemy to come in.

Matthew 15:17-20 Do you not yet understand, that whatsoever enters in at the mouth goes into the belly, and is cast out into the drain? But those things which proceed out of the mouth come forth from the heart; and they defile the man.

For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies: These are the things which defile a man: but to eat with unwashed hands defiles not a man.

Your mouth is guided by the tongue; just as a rudder is able to guide a ship, the tongue steers what people say with their mouths. If your heart is filled with evil, negative thoughts full of malice and strife, that is what will come out of your mouth. However, if your heart is filled with His Presence and His Word, good, positive faith building words will proceed out of your mouth.

James 3:4-6 Behold also the ships, which though they be so great, and are driven by fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small rudder, wherever the pilot desires. Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasts great things.

Behold, how great a forest a little fire kindles! And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defiles the whole body, and sets on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire by hell.

Finally we must watch what we touch, or allow to come in touch with us. We walk on this earth, work and deal with earthly things daily exposing ourselves to many things that can contaminate our soul. This is why it is necessary to cleanse ourselves daily through prayer. Spending time in His presence and reading His word will help us to cleanse ourselves from all worldly contamination.

2 Corinthians 6:17-18 Therefore come out from among them, and be you separate, says the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, And will be a Father unto you, and you shall be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty.
