EFFECTUAL PRAYER



James 5:16-17 "Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that you may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. The early church understood the reality of the supernatural world and lived accordingly. They practiced righteous living and the fear of God. They believed in angels, demons, prayer, fasting and preached conviction messages in the churches. As a result, preachers and believers lived victorious pure lives that glorified and honored the Lord Jesus Christ, and multitudes of people were converted to the kingdom of God.

The present religious wineskin (structure) cannot contain the outpouring that is fixing to take place. Many high places are going to have to come down, and major shifts and changes take place in the Christian Church if it wants to be a part of what the Lord is about to do in the world.
