GROWING IN FAITH #4



Luke 17:5-6 "And the apostles said to the Lord: Increase our faith. And the Lord said: if you had faith as a grain of mustard seed, you could say unto this sycamore tree, be plucked up by the root and planted in the sea and it would obey you."

Our spiritual progress in this life many times could be likened to a staircase. As we move forward in faith, we move upward as well until eventually we reach the floor level that we desire to reach. This journey is not an easy one; it takes effort to climb the stairs, and the further we ascend, the harder it becomes. Sometimes there are distractions along the way.

Any time that He sent forth His power into the earth, He has done it through spoken words, and those words must be spoken through human lips. The will of the Father will not be carried out on the earth until someone speaks forth His decreed will.

Our inability or unwillingness to come into agreement with His decreed will in prayer and declare it with our mouths, will hinder the Kingdom of God from being manifested on the Earth.
