SPIRITUAL WARFARE #3



1 Corinthians 1:27-29 "But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nothing things that are: That no flesh should glory in his presence."

We are going to continue to this lesson on spiritual warfare from a slightly different angle. Whenever we talk about faith, it may sound foolish to the carnal mind who sees everything in terms of the five physical senses. However, from experience I have learned to trust the spiritual dimension much more than I trust the earthly dimension, for the things we see are temporal but the things unseen are eternal.

2 Corinthians 4:18: "While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal."

You see the foolishness of God is much wiser than all the wise men of the earth put together, and the weakness of God is more powerful than the strength of all men put together. We have to begin to look at our problems not through our carnal minds, but through the eyes of Faith in God. *Doubts will keep you defeated and unbelief will keep us away from deliverance and healing of our bodies.* Faith will always lead us to victory over the obstacles that you may be facing.

One of the things that I have learned in my walk with the LORD is that we have to take a stand and claim that which has been given to us through visions, dreams or spoken over us. It is not going to be handed to you in a silver platter just because the LORD showed you something. We must war in the spirit to possess our inheritance. If God's Word makes a promise to you that you need in your life, as long as you keep your part of the covenant you can exercise faith and receive it from God.

There is no substitute for desire and no alternative to action if you want to receive something from God. The examples are all throughout the Bible, from the blind man at Bethesda who had to go wash more than a mile before he was healed to the four men carrying the man with palsy who had to tear a hole in

the roof in order to lower the man to Jesus. Desire must have burned in the hearts of these men for them to have acted so decisively. Such passion will never be denied.

Faith transports a person from the realm of human reason and understanding, into the supernatural realm where the miracle working power of God operates. Faith believes God even when the answer cannot be seen. We are now entering a time when we must not rely upon our carnal powers, but upon the LORD. Without Him, you will be no match for the powers of darkness that are being released upon mankind.

Our Heavenly Father does not need to be bribed or coaxed to act on behalf of His children. He is always available and ready if we would only exercise our faith and call upon Him. His ability is unlimited and there are no limitations in the boundaries of space and time because He exists outside those limitations. If you don't understand this, you could become accustomed to being pushed around by demon powers whose purpose is to oppress and torment mankind.

As a warrior in the Kingdom of our beloved Father you must push back. You can never allow any obstacles to stand between you and the promises of God. You must resist the thoughts of self pity that the enemy plants in your minds, and remember that you are a child of the living God. We have His DNA dwelling within us. This tug of war between our flesh and His Holy Spirit dwelling within our spirit must always be won by our spirit man. The alternative is captivity.

Whenever you live below your spiritual inheritance you limit yourself. That is why it is so important to know your rights in the covenant. Our Heavenly Father is a God of Covenants. If you fail to understand this powerful principle, you will not reap the full benefits of your inheritance in Christ Yahushua. The answer to prayer is connected to two things: knowledge of His Word and dependence upon His Spirit.

If you know what His Word promises and you have faith that His Spirit is present to provide it, then you can pray with assurance that you will receive what you pray for. The devil will always challenge you into think that God doesn't love you or care for you enough to answer your prayers. These thoughts you must cast down and bring every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ.
