THE LIVING WORD #4



Luke 24:30-32 "And it came to pass, as he sat to eat with them, he took bread, and blessed it, and broke it, and gave to them. And their eyes were opened, and they knew him; and he vanished out of their sight. And they said one to another: Did not our hearts burn within us, while he talked with us by the way and opened to us the scriptures?"

What a wonderful thing to be able to open the Holy Bible and read the words of our Creator spoken through the prophets and apostles of old. Mere men like unto us, but men that knew Him, and felt the heartbeat of His heart. It is something how He can still speak to us today through His Word. Luke 6:45: "The good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings out that which is good, and the evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart brings out that which is evil, for out of the abundance of the heart, his mouth speaks."

The cells in our brain are continually dying and being renewed year by year; month by month; week by week; day by day. What was present in your mind today may not be there a year from now.
